ADMINISTRATION

Coordination of Significant Litigation and Other Matters
Involving the Department of Justice

1. **Purpose.** This Instruction assigns responsibilities on significant litigation and matters involving the Department of Justice, which significantly affect the Department of Defense.
2. **Applicability.** This Instruction applies to DISA activities.
3. **Authority.** This Instruction is published in accordance with the authority contained in [DOD Instruction 5030.7](#), Coordination of Significant Litigation and Other Matters Involving the Department of Justice, 22 August 1988.
4. **Responsibilities.** The General Counsel, DISA, will:
 - 4.1 Make all required reports and notifications in accordance with [DODI 5030.7](#).
 - 4.2 Be the primary liaison for DISA to other DOD Components for mutual information and advice concerning all significant court actions conducted by the Department of Justice that may materially affect the administration of DISA or other DOD Components, including the Office of the Secretary of Defense.
